DESCRIPTION:

Due to the possibility of iniciation of cracks produced by corrosion in the support lug of the Flap track, must be accomplished the usual inspection show in the Maintenance Instruction CASA COM 235-58.

Any alternate mean of compliance which provides an acceptable level of safety, may be used, subject to previous approval by DGAC.

COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE:

this established inspection Airworthiness Directive, must be accomplished at the following intervals:

- a) Aircraft with less than 2000 flight hours:
 - 1) First Inspection: During the next "C" or anual inspection.
 - 2) Interval: Each "Y"inspection.
- b) Aircraft with more than 2000 fligt hours:
 - 1) First Inspection: Before of the first fly.
 - 2) Interval: Each "Y" inspection.
