DESCRIPTION:

During a review of the airframe pneumatic de-icing system of CN-235 series, it was detected that a failure condition exists in which the pneumatic supply pressure to the pneumatic boot de-icers could be less than 15 psig, which is the required pressure for proper functioning, without generating the corresponding

caution light in the cockpit.

This Airworthiness Directive mandates a modification to ensure that the flight crew is advised whenever the supply pressure to the pneumatic boot de-icers

is below the required value for its proper operation

COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE: The CASA modification must be accomplished within 4 months.
